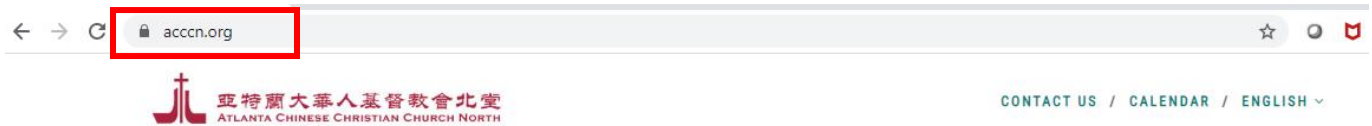
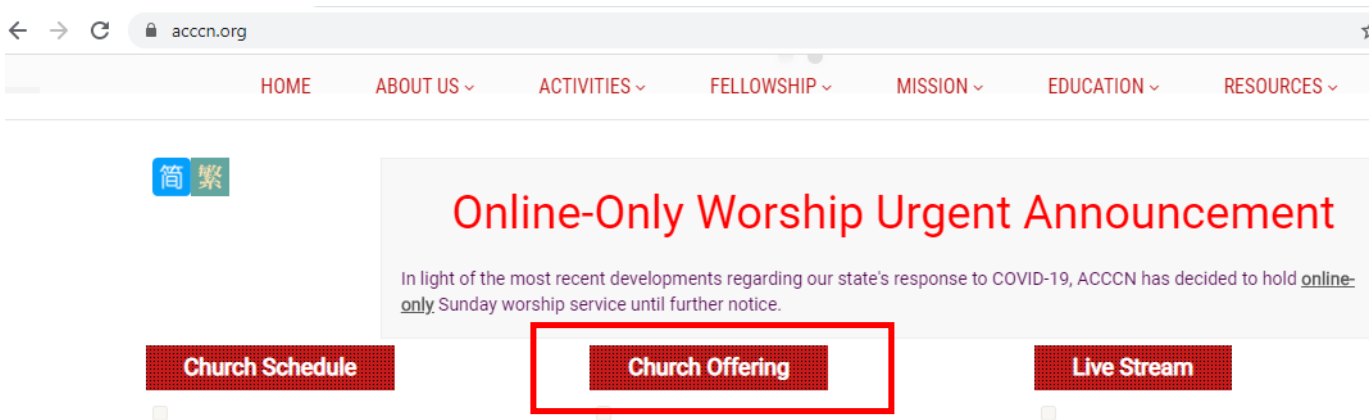


ACCCN Online Offering Instructions
